

First Trumpet

Revelation 8:7
(NKJV) 7 The first angel sounded: And hail and fire followed, mingled with blood, and they were thrown to the earth. And a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.

First Trumpet

Drought: When the grass is killed and the trees are burned up there are environmental consequences.

The next slide shows some figures from National Geographic concerning what the world eats.

Think of these sources of food and where they have their base.

The hail and fire mingled with blood burned all grass and a third of the trees.

All grass – dust storms, animals starving, etc.

Revelation 8:8-9
(NKJV) 8 Then the second angel sounded: And [something] like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood. 9 And a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Second Trumpet

Note something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea!

Some scholars think it is only speaking of the Mediterranean Sea since it was associated with the area of Palestine. However, Rev. 6:14 "...says every mountain and island was moved out of its place." That would indicate the entire earth. Romans 1:18

The trumpets speak of many thirds that will take place.

Third Trumpet

[Rev 8:10-11 NKJV] 10 Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. 11 The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

Third Trumpet

Wormwood is not something you want to consume.
It can be toxic in high doses.
It also has a bitter taste.
A third of the rivers and springs. Drinking water

Fourth Trumpet

[Rev 8:12-13 NKJV] 12 Then the fourth angel sounded: And a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. A third of the day did not shine, and likewise the night. 13 And I looked, and I heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, "Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!"

Fourth Trumpet

A third of the day the sun does not shine. Think of the implications of this.

How would God cause this to be? We know He can and He will. So what!

Nuclear Winter what is that. Scientist believe it would be dust in the atmosphere that would block out the sun and would affect life on the earth.

The next three Trumpets are Woes.

Rev. 8:13 tells us in the fourth trumpet that the last three trumpets (5th, 6th, and 7th trumpets) are three Woe's.

Revelation 8:13 “And I looked, and I heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, “Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blast of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!”

As we study the Scriptures we find God always warns of coming disaster.

When the Israelites were about to cross over into the promised land Moses told them of the blessings and curses that would come upon them in Deuteronomy Chapter Twenty-eight.

The sound of the Fifth, Sixth, and Seventh Trumpets will be a terrible time for man.

An Angel flying through the air sounded with a loud voice, “Woe, woe, woe!”

Fifth Trumpet

[Rev 9:1-12 NKJV] 1 Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit. 2 And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. 3 Then out of the smoke locusts came upon the earth. And to them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power. 4 They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. 5 And they were not given [authority] to kill them, but to torment them [for] five months. Their torment [was] like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man. 6 In those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them. 7 The shape of the locusts was like horses prepared for battle. On their heads were crowns of something like gold, and their faces [were] like the faces of men. 8 They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like lions' [teeth]. 9 And they had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings [was] like the sound of chariots with many horses running into battle. 10 They had tails like scorpions, and there were stings in their tails. Their power [was] to hurt men five months. 11 And they had as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in Hebrew [is] Abaddon, but in Greek he has the name Apollyon. 12 One woe is past. Behold, still two more woes are coming after these things.

The end of the Sixth Trumpet occurs just after the two witnesses are raised and called up to heaven. Rev. 11:3-14.

Rev. 8:13 tells us in the fourth trumpet that the last three trumpets (5th, 6th, and 7th trumpets) are three Woe's.

Rev 11:13 says “In the same hour...” This refers to the breath of life coming into the two dead witnesses and them being called up into heaven.

Rev 11:14 states “The second woe is past.” The second woe is the 6th trumpet and it ends, or is completed, at the end of the two witnesses forty-two months of witnessing. Therefore, the 7th Trumpet will sound early in the last three and one-half years of the Great Tribulations. Remember Jesus called this the Great Tribulations. Matthew 24:41




Sixth Trumpet

[Rev 11:15-19 NKJV] 15 Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdoms of this world have become [the kingdoms] of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!" 16 And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God, 17 saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned. 18 The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, And the time of the dead, that they should be judged, And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, And those who fear Your name, small and great, And should destroy those who destroy the earth." 19 Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.



The end of the Sixth Trumpet occurs just after the two witnesses are raised and called up to heaven. Rev. 11:3-14. Rev. 8:13 tells us in the fourth trumpet that the last three trumpets (5th, 6th, and 7th trumpets) are three Woe's. Rev 11:13 says "In the same hour..." This refers to the breath of life coming into the two dead witnesses and them being called up into heaven. Rev 11:14 states "The second woe is past." The second woe is the 6th trumpet and it ends at the end of the two witnesses forty-two months of witnessing. Therefore, the 7th Trumpet will sound early in the last three and one-half years of the Tribulations. And remember Jesus said this is the great tribulations.

The 70th Week of Daniel or 7 Year Tribulation



Sixth Trumpet

Revelation 9:13-21: 13 Then the sixth angel sounded and heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, 14 saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." 15 So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind. 16 Now the number of the army of the horsemen was two hundred million; I heard the number of them. 17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision: those who sat on them had breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulfur yellow; and the heads of the horses were like the heads of lions; and out of their mouths came fire, smoke, and brimstone. 18 By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed-by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which came out of their mouths. 19 For their power is in their mouth and in their tails; for their tails are like serpents, having heads; and with them they do harm. 20 But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk. 21 And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.



First Bowl
